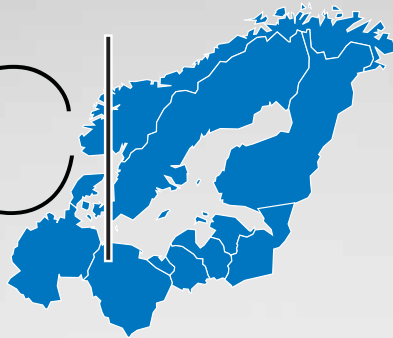

Baltic Sea Innovation Network Centres (BaSIC)

The Baltic Sea Innovation Network Centres create a seamless working environment for innovative tech-based growth companies in the Baltic Sea Region's biggest metropolitan areas.

BaSIC is embedded in a reliable network of leading science parks, innovation environments and clusters.

These 10 urban areas – Berlin, Copenhagen, Helsinki, Oslo, Riga, Stockholm, Tallinn, Vilnius, Warsaw and St Petersburg – boast strong market potential, skilled human resources and strong technical competence.

Connecting the region is a chain of Market Access Points, providing companies with intelligence about business environments, market conditions, regulations, taxes, clusters, regional support and permits – all the factors crucial for market access.



BaSIC Market Access Points Services – Piloting companies into new markets

MARKET ACCESS POINTS (MAP)

Market Access Points are powerful BaSIC instruments to help innovative tech-based growth companies and entrepreneurs find improved access to markets in the Baltic Sea metropolises. MAPs offer synchronised services related to internationalisation needs, including 'soft-landing' services.

MAPs offer the **Local Case Manager for Companies** service, which welcome firms interested in doing business in these cities.

Each Local Case Manager guides their own region's companies outwards and foreign companies inwards to markets in the region.

For firms setting up business in Baltic Sea area cities, MAPs provide the **BaSIC Market Access service**. This service, led by a Case Manager, guides them into the target market and its business and innovation environments.

LOCAL CASE MANAGER AND BASIC MARKET ACCESS SERVICES

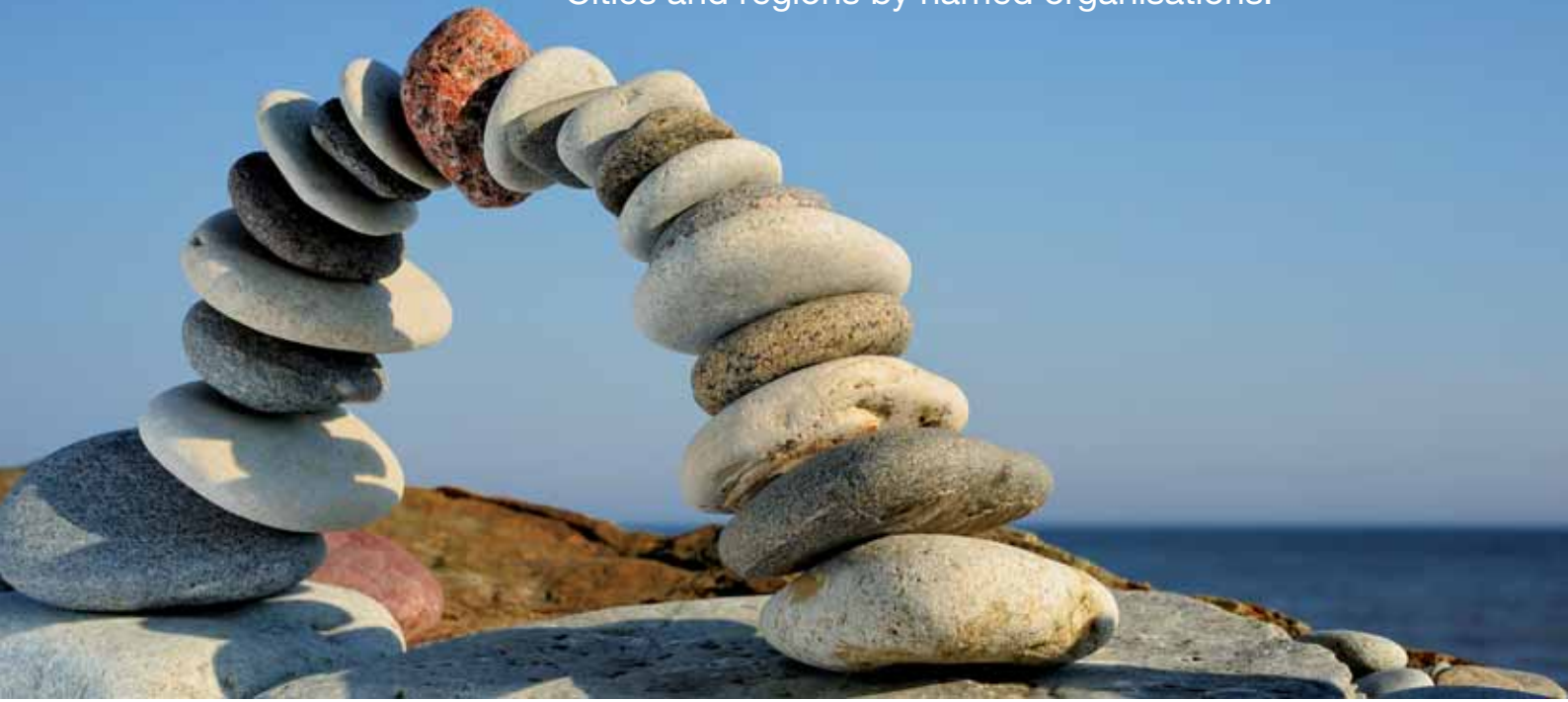
The BaSIC Market Access service assists in entering the target market as well as its business and innovation environments.

Guided by the local Case Manager, the service provides instructions and links in English, advice and practical support in the process of establishing a legal entity and starting a business in a Baltic Sea country. For a reasonable fee, the MAP service provider network offers full assistance in establishing a legal entity.

Companies are able to concentrate on their business development, confident that they have help in practical issues and adapting to the business culture.

After settling in the Baltic Sea Region, firms have access to ongoing MAP operational support in regional services such as business development, planning, recruiting and investment services, finance and funds.
